Responsibilities

- Lead a crew in all aspects of stick framing including trusses, supports, roof decking, exterior decks, pole barns, fascia, soffit, windows, and doors as needed.
- Generate accurate material lists based on assessments of projects.
- Calculate time costs for projects, including labor.
- Oversee other laborers or apprentices, and inspect the work of less experienced workers, including oversight of material usage to insure proper use for quality and cost efficacy.
- Work with foreman and office staff to coordinate scheduling and quality of final product.
- Communicate professionally with customers and office personnel, answering questions and addressing concerns.
- Utilize provided CRM technology to upload photographs of work, to follow schedule of assigned work. *Employee will receive instruction and training on this construction and tracking software during on-boarding*

This is not a new construction position. The primary focus will be decks, porches, fascia, and soffit repair or replacement, with occasional work related to windows, doors, and pole barn construction

- Five years stick framing experience in construction environment.
- Attention to detail and completion of paperwork in a timely manner.
- Customer facing skills, explaining necessary repair work in terms that can be understood by the property owner.
- Must be able to pass a DOT physical and have valid driver's license.
